Enjoy a day in Folkstone and visit the B.o.B. Memorial and the Kent B.o.B. Museum



Sunday 16th September is Battle of Britain Remembrance Day

Enjoy a visit to the town of Folkstone involved in air wars and the evacuation of Dunkirk.

THE VISIT We will be taken by coach to the Harbour Arm area , arriving about 11.00am. You will then be free for two hours to explore the town .

There are numerous places to eat in the harbour area including fish and chip restaurants, pubs, and shell fish salad bars

The coach will leave at 1.00pm to take us to the Battle of Britain Memorial, a new building in the shape of a Spitfire wing. The building contains exhibitions and the Scramble, a hands - on experience including a flight simulator in a Hurricane cockpit.

We will leave at 3.00pm to go to the Kent Battle of Britain museum based on the site of what was RAF Hawkinge. The museum contains a huge collection of aircraft and memorabilia. We expect to be back in Sevenoaks at 6.30pm
