



WINCHELSEA SECRET GARDENS SATURDAY 14 APRIL 2018

We have organised a trip to Winchelsea, East Sussex, one of the best preserved Bastide Towns in Britain. A highlight is to visit some of its rarely-open Gardens.



DEPARTURE: PROMPT at 8.45am - from Baker's Yard (opposite the gasometers). Please arrive 15 minutes before departure to pay £2.50 for carpark (organiser will collect). Coffee is usually available to buy on the coach or bring a flask.

THE VISIT: There are two possible itineraries for the morning: *
1. Arrive Winchelsea about 10.30am and leave the coach to join an 11am tour of the Town's medieval cellars. The tour takes 1 and a half hours and is only for the sure-footed (lots of steps).
2. stay in the coach and go on to Rye (2 miles away) and explore this town before returning to Winchelsea in the coach to visit the gardens which open at 1pm.
*It is not necessary for everyone to choose the same itinerary.

COST: £22 which includes coach travel, gratuities, entry to 6 Secret Gardens. If you wish take Option 1 to include Winchelsea Cellars. the cost is £29.50. Refreshments will be at your own expense. Teas available in the Winchelsea Village Hall. There is also a pub. If it is fine you might bring a picnic. Rye has many cafes.
